A mask-making workshop is included where you can create your own mask to wear to our "Masquerade Happy Hour" before our closing dinner at the Southern Yacht Club, the 2nd oldest Yacht Club in the country. It's a beautiful facility located on the shores of Lake Pontchartrain. A jazz combo will provide entertainment.

There's ample time in the schedule for you to see other sights in the city, shop, or relax for the afternoon.
