Up the Bay Cruise, August 7-13, 2021

Join us, as we cruise through history to “The Old Line State,” the name bestowed upon the state of Maryland by General George Washington in honor of the “Maryland Line,” the state’s regular line troops who served courageously in many Revolutionary War battles.

Our journey begins at Solomons Island on Saturday, August 7, with docktails and a potluck dinner under the tent. A rousing round of Revolution Trivia is in the offing, so don your tricorne thinking caps! Sunday, August 8, you are free to explore Solomons Island, enjoy time with your VYC friends, and visit the Maritime Museum. Sunday evening, we will gather under the tent for a presentation by the curator of the Calvert County Maritime Museum, followed by docktails and dinner on your own. The Omelette Man will be on hand Monday morning to provide a hearty breakfast before our departure for the Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford.

Docktails on the dock and a “Country Picnic” are on tap at the yacht club for our first night in Oxford, along with a visit from Pete Leshner of the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum, who will tell us about the Chesapeake and its role in the Revolution. Tuesday morning, a continental breakfast will be provided at the yacht club, followed by a free day to explore Oxford, visit the Cutts and Case Boatyard, and visit with VYC friends. Tuesday evening, join the group for cocktails and dinner at the Robert Morris Inn.

Thursday, August 12, will mark the end of our cruise into Revolutionary history. We will mark the occasion with a walking/trolley tour of Old Towne Annapolis and the Naval Academy beginning at 10:00, followed by lunch on your own. Our finale dinner will be held at the Eastport Yacht Club, with an appearance by an electrifying VIP guest!
